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SCHOOL OF DANCE

Ballet IV, by recommendation, 3.5 hrs/week

This class is designed for students who have graduated from our Ballet III level or by teacher evaluation. Dancers will develop skill, creativity, and dance knowledge. This class includes pre-pointe or pointe, depending on the student's personal level. We request that these students also take Modern and Contemporary/Jazz Fusion.

Ballet 4A - Tuesdays 4:30-6:00 pm AND Wednesdays 5:30-7:30 pm South

Ballet 4B - Tuesdays 4:30-6:00 pm South AND Thursdays 5:15-6:45 pm Cedar Creek

Ballet V/Pointe, by recommendation, 3 hrs/week

This class is designed for students who have graduated from Ballet IV and have had at least one year of Pointe. We request that these dancers also take Contemporary, Jazz, and Modern.

MODERN - Ages 9+, 1-1.25 hr/week

Modern dance focuses on the dancer's relationship with the floor and the movements tend to be angular and rhythmic. This form of dance is often used to convey intense emotion and can be a powerful storytelling tool. At least one year of prior ballet or jazz experience is recommended.

Children will build their rhythmic and singing skills, develop sensitivity to the expressive qualities in music, and listen to and express music through movement.

TUITION, REGISTRATION, AND COSTUME FEES:

Payment: Monthly tuition is based on total number of classes for the year and divided evenly. It does not vary during holiday months. Payment for the term must be made **with pre-authorized credit/debit card payments or postdated checks at the time of registration.** There is a \$10 per class per student registration fee charged upon enrollment. Registration fees will NOT exceed \$50 per family. Costume fees are \$20 per student for Christmas and \$70 per student per class for spring.
